


Registered Traveller

Faster entry through the UK border for **Australian, Canadian, Japanese, New Zealand** or **American** nationals

What is Registered Traveller?

Registered Traveller offers faster entry through the UK border.

At passport control, you'll:

- be able to use the ePassport gates (if you have a biometric passport)
- be able to use the UK/EU lanes or the Registered Traveller lanes (Gatwick)
- won't have to fill in a landing card or undergo a credibility interview on each arrival
- visa holders won't have to provide fingerprints on each arrival

Who can apply?

To become a Registered Traveller you will need to:

- be a national of Australia, Canada, Japan, New Zealand or the USA
- be 18 years of age or over
- hold a valid visa (exceptions apply) **or**
- be a visitor (and have visited 4 times in the previous 52 weeks) in one of the following categories:
 - Business
 - Tourist
 - Transit
 - Sports
 - Entertainer

How to apply

Go to www.gov.uk/registered-traveller where you will find the online application form.

The form takes **less than 10 minutes** to complete and you need your current passport details.

Please allow 10 working days to get a decision on your application.

How much does it cost?

It costs £70. This includes a non-refundable fee of £20 for considering your application. The remaining £50 is for 12 months membership should you be accepted on to the service.

Where is it available?

Currently the Service is available at:

- Gatwick
- Heathrow
- London City
- Stansted
- Edinburgh
- Glasgow
- Manchester
- Paris, Brussels and Lille (rail terminals)

What happens after I apply?



Background checks

We will carry out checks to see if you are eligible to join.



Provisional acceptance

If your application is provisionally accepted, we will email you instructions on how to complete your membership.



Enrolment

Enrolment as a full member happens at the border the next time you visit the UK.



Full membership

You can then use the ePassport gates (if you have a biometric passport) and the UK/EU lanes.
